Keystone First CHC announces the availability of the 2026 Provider Manual.

Examples of updates and changes include topics such as:

- TeleServices: Included Nutritional Consultation.
- Services Requiring a Referral: Added Doula services.
- Out-of-Plan Referrals: Updated prior authorization requirements and updated website address
- Service Requiring Prior Authorization*: Updated services to include Acupuncture and Select Home Infusion Therapies, deleted Cardiac and Pulmonary Rehabilitation. Updated DME to include Select DME under \$750.
- Nursing Facility Covered Services: Added how providers can submit prior authorization via NaviNet.
- Reporting a Critical Incident: Updated to clarify requirements around identifying the incident and the discovery date of the incident.
- Medical Record Retention Responsibilities: Updated the amount of time medical records must be preserved and maintained.
- Added new sections:
 - Concurrent Care Review
 - Emergency Services Provided by Non-Participating Providers
 - Balance or Surprise Billing
 - High-Cost Gene Therapy
 - What is an SIU Dispute
