We are pleased to announce the release of the 2026 PerformPlus® Open Arms for Nursing Facilities Value-Based Program.

**Program overview update:**

In addition to Nursing Facilities billing at least 10,000 room and board days/units for dates of service within the reporting period, the Nursing Facilities must attend at least one Long-Term Care Learning Network Webinar hosted by the Jewish Healthcare Foundation within the reporting period as well.

**Existing Program Components:**

The Quality Performance Component of the PerformPlus Open Arms for Nursing Facilities will continue to consist of the following measures:

- Percentage of short-stay residents who were rehospitalized after a Nursing Facility admission
- Percentage of high risk long-stay residents with pressure ulcers
- Percentage of long-stay residents experiencing one or more falls with major injury
- Percentage of long-stay residents assessed and appropriately given the seasonal influenza vaccine
- Percentage of long-stay residents assessed and appropriately given the pneumococcal vaccine
- Percentage of long-stay residents who received an antipsychotic medication
- Percentage of long-stay residents with a urinary tract infection
- Staffing ratios (Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Star Rating)
